ABOUT OUR CLASSES

Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education (IELCE) classes

assist adult learners in becoming active participants in their communities. Topics covered help students develop the knowledge and English language skills they need to navigate governmental, educational, financial, healthcare, and other American institutions. They provide the opportunity for non-native English speakers to improve their employability, increase their communication skills in English, and become self-sufficient members of our American society.

These classes are recommended for students who wish to improve their English so they can register in citizenship classes.

Citizenship classes are for adults who are preparing to apply for US citizenship. Topics covered include the naturalization application process, US history and government, and the English vocabulary and skills that are necessary for the citizenship test/interview.

Students need to have at least a low intermediate understanding of English to register.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Registration and Assessment

All new and returning students must attend an orientation and register prior to beginning classes. This includes completing the necessary forms and English skills assessment needed for enrollment.

Students who wish to enroll after orientation must arrange a time to meet with the site Lead Instructor prior to attending.

Attendance

Class times are noted with the site information. Attendance shows that you are serious about wanting to improve your English skills. Students must make every effort to attend all scheduled classes.

Students in all IELCE and the Lilburn citizenship classes are expected to earn at least 60 hours of class attendance during the semester.

Absences

Students who are absent for four class sessions in a row without prior notification may be withdrawn from the program. If they want to return to classes, they will need to re-enroll and may not be able to attend until the next semester.

Class Levels

Class assignments are based on the level of a student's English proficiency, which is determined by an assessment during the registration process. Another assessment is given after 60 hours of attendance to determine student progress.

Childcare

Childcare is NOT provided during classes.
